Project Prattville: The Next Chapter is a twelve month process to update the City of Prattville Comprehensive Development Plan. The City's plan, most recently revised in 1996 and 1998, is the primary guide for growth and development decisions by the City Council and Prattville Planning Commission. Project Prattville will account for the remarkable growth and transformation the city has experienced over the last decade and prepare for the expected changes over the next two decades.

Following the example of past planning efforts, Project Prattville is relying heavily on public participation and input to formulate future growth policies and to identify needed projects. The
