Project Prattville is entering an important stage in the study process. After completing the Inventory and Assessment Report (available at www.projectprattville.com) the effort turned toward Plan development. This phase kicked off on February 23rd with the Prattville Compass. This graphic survey was designed to help the citizens of Prattville identify images and development types that they felt best represented their views of the future of their City. The Compass continued on-line for another month, and by the end of March, scores of residents had made their opinions known.

Informed by the Compass results and the recently completed Market Assessment, Project Prattville now focuses in even further. The study will begin to look in more detail at specific areas within the City, addressing a number of issues: What areas are likely to develop, and what areas are desirable to develop? What transportation improvements would have the greatest impact, and what are their priorities? Where new public amenities are needed and how would they be connected to the surrounding community? How will the Prattville of 2030 be different from the Prattville of today? How will it be the same?

These questions, among others, will be the focus of the upcoming **third public meeting, the Prattville Workshop**. Scheduled for **Tuesday, May 12, 6:00 p.m. at Doster Community Center**, this interactive meeting will be unlike the two prior. At this meeting, attendees will be *participants*, broken into small teams and charged with addressing many of the challenges facing the City. The Workshop will begin with an overview of the process thus far, including a review of the Compass results, and will also include a look at the initial results of the Market Assessment and suggestions for priority transportation projects. Once that's done, folks will roll up their sleeves and get into the details of planning Prattville's future. Each table will have a professional facilitator to help guide the discussion, and the workshop itself will consist of a series of rapid-fire questions and quick tasks, aimed at tackling the strategic issues that are key to creating a viable Project Prattville. It will be challenging, engaging, and most of all, entertaining!
